Mexican Consulate signs agreement to strengthen legal orientation for Mexicans

The Consulate of Mexico in Douglas, Arizona signed an agreement with the organization We Are One Family Immigration Project, in order to provide the Mexican population with information and legal orientation specialized in naturalization workshops, which will take place in the facilities of this Consular representation.

In the framework of the actions to strengthen the care of migrants in the United States (FAMEU), on Wednesday 25 October at 10:30 a.m. at the headquarters of the Mexican Consulate, Consul Jorge Ernesto Espejel Montes formalized the agreement with attorney Susan L. Kolb, whereby Mexican citizens with the status of legal permanent residents of the United States are expected to access American nationality and identify migratory remedies for other Mexicans susceptible to regularization.

From the opening of the "Migrant Defense Center" in early March, whose main objective is to meet the needs of information and legal representation of Mexicans living in the United States, to the signing of this agreement, the Consulate of Mexico in Douglas reiterates its commitment to provide timely information and assistance to the Mexican nationals living in this area.
